ImagineU Application

Program Overview

The ImagineU Summer Entrepreneurship Accelerator program is a unique, immersive and intensive **12-week entrepreneurial experience** in which students learn and live the early-stages of their entrepreneurship journey. This program emphasizes diversity and inclusion. In order to make the experience accessible to all, the **program pays participating students up to a \$3,000 stipend**. During the program, students will identify problems at the intersections of their passion, experience and knowledge, and will start a company with other students around the most compelling and feasible opportunities identified in the early stages of the program.

Dates & Deadlines

Dates: May 18 - August 8, 2025

The program begins on May 18, 2025, and runs through August 8, 2025. Approximately 1-2 weeks before the start of the program, there is an orientation event to give everyone an opportunity to meet other students participating in the program and provide details on how to prepare for Day 1.

Applications Deadline: March 2, 2025

Applications are due by March 2, 2025. The program is competitive; we don't recommend waiting until the last minute to apply. We're not looking for people that want a backup plan. We are looking for motivated students that are serious about experiencing a real-world entrepreneurship and understand they are going to start a company during this program.

The ImagineU Summer Accelerator is an interdisciplinary program. We welcome students from all majors and academic interests. As long as you have a minimum of one summer (Summer 2025) semester left before graduating from the University of Memphis, you are eligible to apply.

- Elaborate on what skills you have and how you will use and develop them during this summer experience (200-300 words)

- Tell us about an experience you've had working in a group. What did you learn from the experience? (200-400 words)

Hint: this is important. Don't blow off the answer and think carefully about the message you want to send us with your response.

- Do you have a problem you are motivated to solve? If so, tell us about it and why you are motivated to solve it. If you have a startup idea, this is where you pitch it to us. *We want to get an idea of what piques your interest. What is something you would be interested in building a startup around? This is not required, but gives us some insight into your entrepreneurial potential and aspirations.*

- What is the biggest risk you've ever taken? (150-400 words) What was the result? *Hint. This is also important. If you've never taken a risk, be prepared to tell us why you haven't.*

- Tell us about a time you failed and how you handled it (150-400 words) *Also important. Entrepreneurs fail frequently. This program is no exception. Put some thought into this.*

- What do you most hope to gain from this summer experience? What impact will it have on you? (150-400 words)

- Optional: Create a short video (5 minutes or less) introducing yourself, why you want to be in this program, any entrepreneurial experience you have (it's not required), any special skills you have, and why you think we should select you for the program.
