WHAT IS SPASMODIC DYSPHONIA (SD)?

- A rare neurological voice disorder caused by the brain sending abnormal signals to the vocal folds.
- Also referred to as a “laryngeal dystonia,” SD is characterized by involuntary movement of the vocal folds.
- SD is NOT a psychological problem.
- SD is incurable.
- SD affects about 4 people out of every 100,000 individuals.
