



While most of today's discussion of AI and software testing centers on how to test Al-oriented applications, they are looking at how Generative AI can aid in the testing of any application. In 2024, they benchmarked software test cases produced by ChatGPT4o against test cases produced by the more traditional methods of Test First Development (TFD) and pairwise analysis using the MS PICT tool, for their comparative effectiveness in finding software defects. In 2025, they intend to


