THE DOCTORAL PROGRAM OF MANAGEMENT is a full-time, four-year, research-oriented program. Intensive research seminars are offered in human resource management, organizational behavior, organization theory, strategic management, research methods and statistics. The goal of our program is to train students to publish cutting-edge, theory-driven research in premier scholarly journals and subsequently obtain positions at research universities.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Fall | February 1

Applicants must complete an undergraduate degree (a master's degree is preferred but not required), submit a GMAT/GRE score that is not more than five years old and submit three letters of recommendation to be considered for the program. Students are expected to be enrolled in the program on a full-time basis during their course work and one year during their dissertation stage. Doctoral candidates must register for dissertation credit each academic semester until the dissertation is completed in order to remain in active status. PhD students are expected to develop a high level of skills in both research and teaching. Doctoral students are provided ample opportunity to develop these skills through class work, seminars and assistantships.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The Management PhD Concentration Curriculum consists of 39+ hours:

- **RESEARCH CORE**
at least 12 semester hours
- **CONCENTRATION**
at least 30 semester hours
- **DISSERTATION**
minimum of 6 but not more than 18 semester hours
