## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**APPLICATION DEADLINES** Fall | March 1

To apply, PhD candidates must have an undergraduate or a graduate degree in BIT or business-related fields with excellent academic performance. We advise for applicants to obtain balanced quantitative and verbal scores on the GMAT or GRE (GMAT above 600 or equivalent GRE), have competency in written and spoken English and display adequate logical reasoning and critical thinking skills.

For fullest consideration, we encourage prospective students to apply as early as possible. Although the deadline for submissions is March 1 every year, admission decisions are often made before the deadline.
