# **BIOGRAPHIES**

**Francis Cathlina**, D.M.A. (he/him) is a distinguished Vietnamese-American conductor and educator, known for his innovative programming that seamlessly weaves choral music with narrative. His transformative concert experiences invite audiences into a world where choral artistry becomes a powerful storytelling medium.

A two-time GRAMMY-nominated educator, Dr. Cathlina currently serves as the Director of Choral Activities at the University of Memphis Rudi E. Scheidt School of Music. He oversees the Choral Area, leads the MM and DMA Choral Conducting program, and conducts the University Singers.

Dr. Cathlina's Eastern heritage shapes his dedication to collaboration and excellence. His 2025 international engagements include an invitation to work with the Brazilian Choral Directors Association, serving as the Conducting Faculty for the 2025 XV FIMUS Festival in Brazil, and selection for ACDA's International Conductors Exchange Program to the Philippines. Early in his career, the Texas Choral Directors Association (TCDA) designated him the "Young Director of Distinction."

Dr. Cathlina's teaching philosophy centers on developing masterful technicians, creative communicators, and responsible citizens. Under his direction, the UofM University Singers have been invited to perform for national and state conferences. His former students successfully lead programs at universities, public schools, prominent churches, and community choirs. Driven by a passion for human connection, he finds great inspiration as an honor choir conductor. Upcoming and recent engagements involve the International Mu Phi Convention Chorus, Mississippi All-State Treble Choir, Kentucky All-State SATB Choir, Carnegie Hall, and honor choirs nationwide.

A recognized authority in vocal pedagogy, Dr. Cathlina's research focuses on choral tone and conducting gesture. He has published articles in international journals and has presented over 60 interest sessions across the globe. In 2023, he co-led two Conducting Masterclasses in Greece with the University of Macedonia (Thessaloniki) and Ionian University (Corfu). In 2025, he is set to be the Choral Headliner for the Alabama Music Educators Association Conference.

# **BIOGRAPHIES**

Dr. Cathlina holds a D.M.A. in conducting with a vocal pedagogy cognate from the University of North Texas, an M.M. from Michigan State University, and a B.M.E. from Baylor University. Before his doctorate, he taught in Texas public schools. Beyond the podium, Dr. Cathlina is an avid pickleball player. He, his husband Kyle, and their dog Coco proudly call Memphis, Tennessee, their home. www.franciscathlina.com.

## **Graduate Choral Conducting Studio**

Karen Zeferino (b. 1996) was born in Maringá, Brazil, where she first studied piano with her father. She later explored piano, guitar, and choral singing at the UEM Music School, which inspired her to pursue a degree in conducting. While studying at the State University of Maringá, she served as an assistant conductor for various choirs and ensembles, including the UEM Flute and Strings Ensembles. In Brazil, Karen participated in masterclasses with renowned conductors like Marco Antonio da Silva Ramos, Alessandro Sangiorgi, and Abel Rocha. She also conducted performances at the Londrina Music Festival and with the OSUEL Orchestra. Karen pursued a Master of Music in Choral Conducting at the University of Missouri-Columbia (2021-23), where she was a teaching assistant for several choirs. She also attended masterclasses with distinguished conductors like Dr. Marques L.A. Garrett, Dr. Derrick Fox, and Rick Bjella. In July 2022, she conducted the Tacoma Symphony and Tacoma Symphony Voices during the Cascade Conducting Masterclass.

#### **Collaborative Pianist**

Amy Nguyen currently serves as the collaborative artist for the University of Memphis Choral Arts Department. She regularly performs with students, faculty, and guest artists at the University of Memphis. She works throughout the Mid-South, performing at area high schools, colleges, and churches. Nguyen has performed throughout the country, including performances with the Independence Symphony, the Kansas City Symphony, and the Memphis Symphony Orchestra. She has played for the West TN Youth Chorus and the Collegiate School of Memphis.

Nguyen started her piano studies at the age of five. She earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree with Honors from Graceland University where she studied with Charles Schmidt. Under the tutelage of Richard Smith, she earned a Master of Music Degree from Central Missouri State University. She also studied with Betty Mallard at the University of Texas at Austin.

# **BIOGRAPHIES**

Adrian Maclin is in his twelfth year as director of choirs at Cordova High School and his nineteenth year of teaching. While at Cordova, his groups have performed at the Southern Division of the American Choral Directors Association conference, the Tennessee Music Educators Association conference, Carnegie Hall, and in numerous halls throughout the country, and recently their first international tour to London, England. His ensembles are widely known for their inspiring, thought provoking, and moving performances.

In addition to Adrian's work at Cordova, he serves the Memphis- Shelby County School district on the Music Leadership team. Adrian also serves on the board of the West Tennessee Vocal Music Educator Association as Past-President, State Choral Chair for the Tennessee Music Educators Association and has served on the board for the State Chapter of the American Choral Director's Association.

Maclin has faithfully served his home church of Mount Moriah -East Baptist Church for 20 years as the Minister of Music. He also serves as the Assistant Artistic Director for the Memphis Choral Arts as primary conductor for the Memphis Men's Chorale. In 2020, Adrian was recognized by the Country Music Association Foundation as one of their Music Teachers of Excellence award and is the 2025 Music Educator Award recipient presented by the Recording Academy and Grammy Museum.
