





Children with Normal Hearing wanted for a Research Study on Hearing and Language Abilities to help Children with Hearing Loss

- The Pediatric Auditory Research Laboratory is conducting a study on the effects of environmental noise exposure on the development of hearing and language abilities in young children with hearing loss.
- Seeking children from 1 year to 6 years old.
- Your child will be tested three different times in the research laboratory where they will hear different speech sounds in quiet and with noise while brain responses are recorded.
- The testing session will last less than about one hour.
- You will use the Language Environment Analysis (LENA) technology at home in order to measure your child's environmental noise exposure.
- Your participation will help children who have hearing loss.
- Your child must not have hearing loss.
- Families will receive \$50 to compensate for their time and driving expenses per session.
