

2024 PH-IDEAS Community Workshop Series



This workshop series is sponsored by PH- IDEAS- a collaboration between Shelby County Health Department and the university of Memphis School of Public Health, funded by CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention).

The 2024 ECoP Workshop Series, presented by PH-IDEAS, is a research-driven initiative aimed at enhancing the ECoP mentorship program. This series incorporates innovative practices such as fictive kinship, emotional literacy, narrative therapy, and role play, all while centering Black lived experiences and cultural identities. The workshops are designed to explore how these culturally resonant approaches can foster personal and collective trust, improve emotional well-being, and strengthen community cohesion.

ECoP is dedicated to strengthening employers' workforces by leveraging its unique Shepherd model, which connects courageous employers with exceptional workers. This approach is specifically designed to promote sustainability, living wage earnings, and economic mobility for justice-involved adults and dislocated workers in Greater Memphis.

The workshop series will run from August 9th, 2024, to December 12th, 2024, with sessions held every Friday from 8:30 AM to 10:30 AM.
